#### **Rules for Changing Singular to Plural**

Rule 1: Add –s to the singular

Most nouns form plural by adding –s.

**Rule 2:** Add —es to nouns ending in s, ss, sh, ch, x, or o

bus buses
glass glasses
class classes
brush brushes
dish dishes
match matches

branch branches

box boxes fox foxes

**Rule 3:** If noun ends in consonant + y, change  $y \rightarrow i$  and add -es

heroes

## Singular Plural

baby babies
lady ladies
city cities
army armies
country countries
story stories
family families

**Rule 4:** If noun ends in f / fe, change to v and add —es

Singular	Plural
leaf	leaves
wolf	wolves
wife	wives
life	lives
knife	knives
calf	calves

**Rule 5:** Irregular Plural (word changes completely)

Singular	Plural
man	men
woman	women
child	children
foot	feet
tooth	teeth
mouse	mice
goose	geese
ОХ	oxen
person	people
die	dice
